

# What you need to know about Burn Permits:

Permits are available online at [health.mesacounty.us](http://health.mesacounty.us)

Two types of permits are available:

- General Burn Permits cost \$10 per permit and are valid for 14 days after purchase.
- Agricultural Burn Permits don't require a fee and are valid until Dec. 31, 2017.
  - It's important to get your Agricultural Burn Permit, because air quality regulations and fire safety regulations have been combined.
  - Registering for this permit gives your local fire department a heads up that you'll be burning.

**The new system will use your information to determine which type of burn permit you need, according to zoning of your property.**
